The Old Course Hotel

Bordering the renowned 17th "Road Hole" of the Old Course, the Old Course Hotel overlooks the famous links courses, the West Sands Beach and the beautiful Scottish coastline. This prestigious AA Five Star-awarded hotel is recognized as one of Europe's leading resorts.





Jubilee Course

The third championship course at the Home of Golf, the Jubilee is considered by many to be the most challenging course on the famous Links. Built in 1897, it was originally intended for use by ladies and beginners; however, after seeing its prime golfing location between the New Course and the sea, the Jubilee was converted to a championship layout in 1988.









The Old Course

The Old Course at St Andrews is considered by many to be the "home of golf" and has hosted a stagering 29 Open Championships. From the looming R&A behind the 1st tee to Hell Bunker, the Road Hole and the Swilcan Bridge, the Old Course is the oldest and most iconic golf course in the world. Ranked #3 in the world, it's on every golfers bucket list!





FEATURED COURSE

Kingsbarns

Kingsbarns is proud to be part of the heritage of links golf around St Andrews. Located 7 miles southeast of the "home of golf," the game has been played on site since 1793 and the present world #64 layout was completed in 2000 by Kyle Phillips.

Many Guests rank Kingsbarns as their favorite in Scotland!









Dumbarnie Links

At first glance Dumbarnie Links may have the appearance of the style of the classic links courses where The Open Championship has been played since 1860. However, the extensive 345-acre site at Dumbarnie is particularly special. Its dual elevations, which are connected by a flowing escarpment, have provided the opportunity to create a number of elevated tees where holes play directly towards panoramic views of the expansive Firth of Forth.







Carnoustie

Golf has been played over the links at Carnoustie since the 1500's, but the present course came into being in 1850 when it was designed by Alan Robertson of St Andrews, and later redesigned by Old Tom Morris. Ranked #28 in the world, it has hosted many memorable Open Championships, the most recent one won in 2018 by Francesco Molinari. It's the site of the tragic "les miserables" collapse by Jean Van de Velde.
