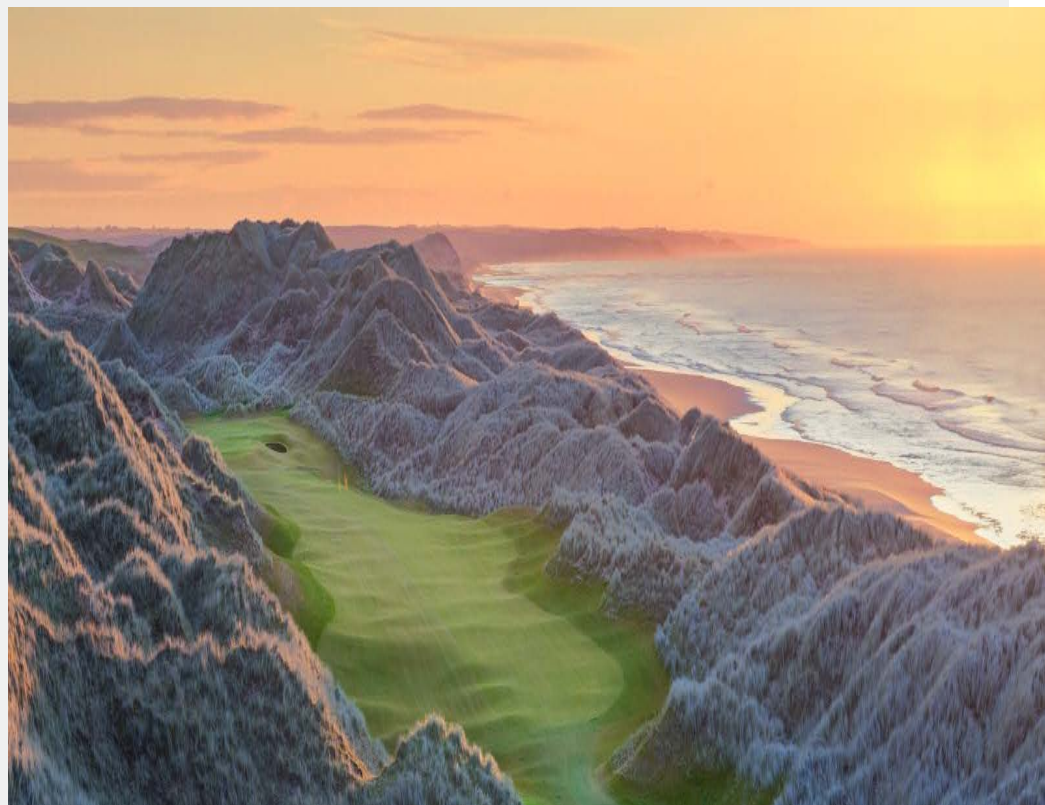




FEATURED COURSE

Trump International Golf *Links*

Set amidst The Great Dunes of Scotland, Trump International embraces mile after mile of spectacular Aberdeenshire coastline and guarantees the experience of a lifetime. All 18 holes thread their way engagingly through the dunes, rising to find views of the sea and coastline, offering a sequence of superlative topographies, landscapes, alternating between spaciousness and enclosure surrounding the golf holes.



FEATURED COURSE

Murcar Golf *Links*

Murcar Links Golf Club is a golf club in northern Aberdeen, Scotland, to the north of the Royal Aberdeen Golf Club. The 18-hole, par 71, 6,156 yard course was established in 1909. and the course was designed by Archie Simpson. The Scottish Golf Union cites it as "one of the most celebrated courses in Scotland".





FEATURED COURSE

Royal *Aberdeen*

Royal Aberdeen is the sixth oldest golf club in the world, set just north of Aberdeen on Scotland's northeast coastline. This stretch of land along the North Sea yields some of Scotland's most dramatic dunesland. The front nine especially is set on the most rugged terrain and is renowned as one of Scotland's finest. The course is considered one of Scotland's most challenging, especially with the high winds that can often be a factor on this side of the island.





FEATURED ACTIVITY

Strathisla *Distillery*

Originally established in 1786, Strathisla is the oldest working distillery in the Scottish Highlands. Located in the Speyside region, it was the first distillery owned by the Chivas Brothers and to this day, Strathisla Single Malt is at the heart of each and every Chivas Regal blend. Spend an hour (or three) in expert yet relaxed company discovering everything there is to know about Strathisla, the ancient craft of distilling spirits, and the rare skill behind our blends.





FEATURED COURSE

Royal *Dornoch*

Royal Dornoch is spellbinding and many golfers from all over the world make the pilgrimage to this natural links at some point in their lives. It is often quoted as one of the must-play courses. It's the timeless setting that makes Royal Dornoch such a pleasing place to play golf. It's wild, isolated and, at the same time, absolutely beautiful; there's the blaze of colour in early summer when the gorse is in flower. The pure white sandy beach divides the links from the Dornoch Firth and it all feels very humbling.



FEATURED COURSE

Castle *Stuart*

Castle Stuart Golf Links, a championship links course overlooking the Moray Firth and well-known landmarks that are synonymous with Inverness and the Black Isle – Kessock Bridge and Chanonry Lighthouse perhaps the most notable. Castle Stuart can be described as a throwback to golf as it once was – a simple walk through pleasing natural surrounds with some companionable and competitive rules attached to it.



FEATURED COURSE

Nairn Golf *Club*

Ranked number 11 in the list of Top 100 Courses in Scotland 2015 (Golf World Magazine), this Traditional Scottish Golf Links Course was created from a Highland wilderness of gorse and heather, and tests the talents of professional and amateur alike. Founded in 1887, it is now one of the best courses in Scotland, and has hosted a large number of important championships.
