FEATURED COURSE

Kingsbarns

Kingsbarns is proud to be part of the heritage of links golf around St Andrews. Located 7 miles southeast of the “home of golf,” the game has been played on site since 1793 and the present world #64 layout was completed in 2000 by Kyle Phillips. Many Guests rank Kingsbarns as their favorite in Scotland!





FEATURED ACTIVITY

Kingsbarns Whisky *Distillery*

Visit this 5-star distillery and visitor centre in the East Neuk of Fife for whisky and gin tours, tastings and delicious local food served in our cafe. They have 3 types of whisky distillery tours suitable for all levels of whisky interest.





FEATURED COURSE

Carnoustie

Golf has been played over the links at Carnoustie since the 1500's, but the present course came into being in 1850 when it was designed by Alan Robertson of St Andrews, and later redesigned by Old Tom Morris. Ranked #28 in the world, it has hosted many memorable Open Championships, the most recent one won in 2018 by Francesco Molinari. It's the site of the tragic "les miserables" collapse by Jean Van de Velde.



FEATURED COURSE

The New *Course*

When it comes to golf, few things in St Andrews are new, so don't let the name fool you. The "New" links were laid out in 1895 and therefore it is plenty old and has had loads of time to mature into a first rate Scottish links golf course. Many locals love it as much as the Old Course, and its certainly just as challenging when the wind is up!



FEATURED ACTIVIT

St. Andrews *Cathedral*

Known as the largest church in Scotland, St Andrews Cathedral fell into disuse during the Scottish Reformation movement during the 16th century when the Catholic mass was outlawed in Scotland. The large complex of impressive ruins is free to visit.





FEATURED ACTIVITY

Edinburgh: Royal Mile

Stretching from the high-on-a-hill Edinburgh Castle to the Holyroodhouse Palace, the Royal Mile is both Old Town Edinburgh's main thoroughfare and one of the city's main streets. Here you'll find top attraction after top attraction, including the Scotch Whisky Experience and Camera Obscura and World of Illusions, as well as a big concentration of shops, restaurants and pubs housed in stunning architecture along this cobblestone street.





FEATURED COURSE

Dumbarnie *Links*

At first glance Dumbarnie Links may have the appearance of the style of the classic links courses that have been around for 150 years or more. However the course only opened for play in May of 2020. Since that date it has received high acclaim throughout the golf world and has already become a favorite for visitors from all around the world.



Edinburgh: Calton Hill

One of the most popular vantage points for photo ops (and included in the city's UNESCO World Heritage site distinction), Calton Hill affords a majestic panorama of the city below – so don't forget to bring your camera, or make sure your phone is charged.
