The Island Golf Club

Portmarnock

Ranked amongst the top golf courses in the world,
Portmarnock is arguably one of the best Championship
Courses in Ireland. The course layout has been
completely crafted by the natural land and is surrounded
by water on three sides. Often at the mercy of the wind,
Portmarnock is quite a formidable test for golfers of any
skill level, which is why it has become quite the popular
location for some of golf's biggest competitions including
the Walker Cup, the Irish Open and the Canada Cup.









Dublin

Old Head

It is a piece of golf real estate like no other, that causes many a golfer and visitor to pinch themselves as they drive through the ancient gateway with the crashing waves of the Atlantic Ocean some 300 feet below.

Portstewart


