No.1 St. Andrews

Say hello to No.1 St Andrews, your private residence in the heart of beautiful St Andrews. Jubilee Course

The third championship course at the Home of Golf, the Jubilee is considered by many to be the most challenging course on the famous Links. Built in 1897, it was originally intended for use by ladies and beginners; however, after seeing its prime golfing location between the New Course and the sea, the Jubilee was converted to a championship layout in 1988.









The Old Course

The Old Course at St Andrews is considered by many to be the "home of golf" and has hosted a staggering 30 Open Championships. From the looming R&A behind the 1st tee to Hell Bunker, the Road Hole and the Swilcan Bridge, the Old Course is the oldest and most iconic golf course in the world. Ranked #3 in the world, it's on every golfers bucket list!





FEATURED ACTIVITY

St. Andrews *Cathedral*

Known as the largest church in Scotland, St Andrews Cathedral fell into disuse during the Scottish Reformation movement during the 16th century when the Catholic mass was outlawed in Scotland. The large complex of impressive ruins is free to visit.









Kingsbarns is proud to be part of the heritage of links golf around St Andrews. Located 7 miles southeast of the "home of golf," the game has been played on site since 1793 and the present world #64 layout was completed in 2000 by Kyle Phillips. Many Guests rank Kingsbarns as their favorite in Scotland!









Dumbarnie Links

At first glance Dumbarnie Links may have the appearance of the style of the classic links courses where The Open Championship has been played since 1860. However, the extensive 345-acre site at Dumbarnie is particularly special. Its dual elevations, which are connected by a flowing escarpment, have provided the opportunity to create a number of elevated tees where holes play directly towards panoramic views of the expansive Firth of Forth.
