# Intercontinental *Porto*

The five-star Inter-Continental lies in the heart of Porto's historic center and is the gem in the city's accommodation crown. ## Douro Valley

The Douro Valley could as easily be called the enchanted valley, such is the beauty and magic that its landscapes offer. With a history of 2000 years of wine production, this UNESCO heritage site also happens to be the most ancient wine region in the world. The landscapes of the Douro Valley are a truly unique and breathtaking sight. Rolling green and golden hills, terraced vineyards clinging to the steep slopes leading down to a beautiful flowing river below.





## Solar do Castelo

The hotel sits within the walled complex of St. George's Castle, high above the city, on the site of the former Alca ova Palace. The 20 individually decorated rooms skilfully blend modern comforts with ancient artifacts and the walls, in Lisbon's traditional yellow, enclose a cobbled courtyard.









## Lisbon

Lisbon is not subtle with its charms. From the first tram ride up that cobbled hill, you will be seduced by glittering river views, some of the most majestic architecture in Europe and, er, washing lines crammed with colorful underwear. Drink with arty locals at hip new bars, sway to fado, the city's signature sound, and load your suitcase with retro souvenirs. For a capital city, they don't get much prettier, and it's outstandingly good value, too.





## Oitavos Dunes GC

Golf Magazine's #1 in Portugal and #55 in the World, Oitavos Dunes peers down at the Atlantic Ocean at every turn. A 5 star private club, Oitavos Dunes is a lovely mix of woodland and links style holes. Designed by the renowned Arthur Hills, Oitavos Dunes is a wonderfully challenging yet playable 18 holes that have been laid out to highlight the existing landscape.









## Cascais

Cascais is the premier holiday destination of the Lisbon coastline. It is a traditional and charming fishing town that has responsibly developed into a popular resort town. Found within the historic center are fascinating museums, along with lively bars and restaurants which give Cascais its holiday atmosphere. Its a town that boasts so many interesting sights and attractions, that it is not only regarded as a one of the best day trips from Lisbon, but as a viable alternative to stay, outside of the capital city.






## Penha Longa Atlantico








## Sintra

## Convento

With peaceful interiors, cloaked in stillness, this is a place to retreat to. There is a swimming pool for the active, but otherwise this is a place to read and think, with no televisions to distract you.







## Quinta Do Lago - South

Quinta do Lago has been at the forefront of international golf since it's creation. Today the three courses are among some of Europe's best and are the home to the Paul McGinley golf academy. The South course is the crown jewel of Quinta do Lago and is a continued favorite of European Tour players, having hosted the Portugal Open 7 times.








## Monte Rei
