Kauri Cliffs Lodge

The lodge and course at Kauri Cliffs are situated on the truly spectacular Pacific Ocean coast, a little north of the Bay of Islands. Sixteen rooms feature in eight separate cottages looking from the edge of native New Zealand forest, across the golf course to the Pacific Ocean and coastal islands.





FEATURED COURSE

Kauri Cliffs

Kauri Cliffs features 18 holes of golf designed by David Harman. 15 holes have spectacular views of the Pacific Ocean, 6 of which are played alongside cliffs that plunge to the sea. Both the Cavalli Islands and Cape Brett provide additional backdrop.








Te Arai Suites






FEATURED COURSE

Te Arai Links

Te Arai's South Course land forms vary from heaving sand ridges and meandering valleys to rumpled contours reminiscent of the classic seaside links on which the game began. These contours are the foundation and inspiration for the golf holes of Te Arai Links. The holes are as varied in appearance and character as the land itself.







The Farm at Cape *Kidnappers*

Located in the Hawke's Bay and set on 6,000 acres of dramatic coastline, The Farm at Cape Kidnappers offers spectacular views from every angle of the Pacific Ocean. On the exterior, the lodge resembles a cluster of farm buildings, whilst on the interior guests will find graciously scaled rooms full of natural light and unexpected treasures.







FEATURED COURSE

Cape Kidnappers

Cape Kidnappers was designed by Tom Doak and completed in 2004. The course has stunning sea views, playing high above the ocean atop dramatic cliffs. It is built on a ridge-and-valley landscape and has been hailed as one of the great modern marvels in golf.

Jack's Point

The John Darby designed 18-hole par 72 course provides a range of challenges for both experienced and beginner golfers. The 6,388-meter undulating course follows natural contours and features tussock grasslands, dramatic rocky outcrops and steep bluffs offset by striking alpine and lake views.
