

Castle Stuart

Castle Stuart Golf Links, a championship links course overlooking the Moray Firth and wellknown landmarks that are synonymous with Inverness and the Black Isle – Kessock Bridge and Chanonry Lighthouse perhaps the most notable. Castle Stuart can be described as a throwback to golf as it once was – a simple walk through pleasing natural surrounds with some companionable and competitive rules attached to it.







Nairn Golf *Club*

Ranked number 11 in the list of Top 100 Courses in Scotland 2015 (Golf World Magazine), this Traditional Scottish Golf Links Course was created from a Highland wilderness of gorse and heather, and tests the talents of professional and amateur alike. Founded in 1887, it is now one of the best courses in Scotland, and has hosted a large number of important championships.

Brora Golf *Club*

The golf course design is recognised as being one of James Braid's finest pieces of work. The green staff work tirelessly to preserve the original design, whilst presenting a course that is regularly acclaimed for its quality. The perfect balance between challenge and fun, and in a breath-taking setting.



Dornoch *Station*

The hotel sits in its own grounds with stunning views over the world famous Royal Dornoch Golf Course to the beach and sea beyond. The rooms and suits are an extension of the Highlands they call home. Royal Dornoch
