Cacela *Velha*

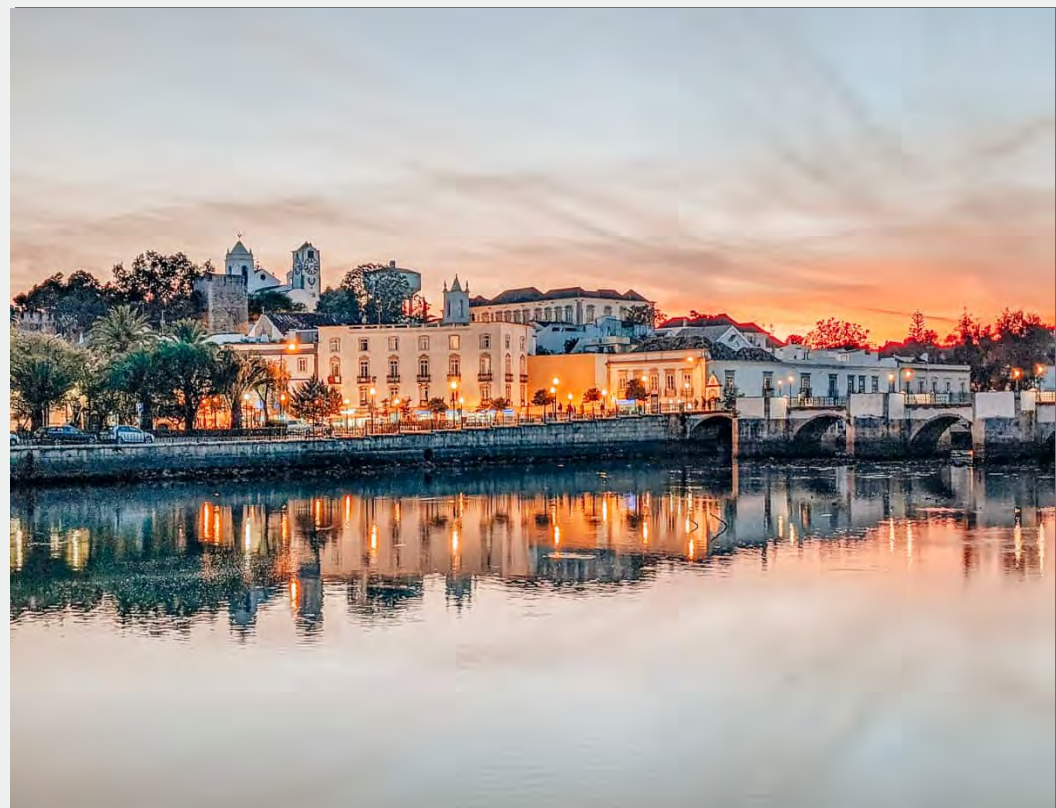

Tavira

Concealed within the labyrinth of cobbled street are traditional tiled houses, family fun restaurants and a myriad of decorative churches.

Faro

Faro is a historic and culturally rich city that boasts a variety of fascinating attractions. Found within the historic quarter is a Gothic Cathedral, the Paco Episcopal Palace. Outside of the city walls is a vibrant village with pedestrian shopping streets, colorful plazas and a wide variety of restaurants and bars. To the south of Faro, the Parque Natural da Ria Formosa is a series of saltwater lagoons and waterways that provide an important ecosystem for migratory birds and marine life.

FEATURED COURSE

Quinta Do Lago - *North*

The Quinta do Lago North Golf course has four great long par 5 holes that need strong fairway play combined with accuracy to succeed in maintaining a low score. The 14th hole of the Quinta do Lago North Course is outstanding. In general it can be considered a course for players who know how to 'draw the ball'.

Coimbra

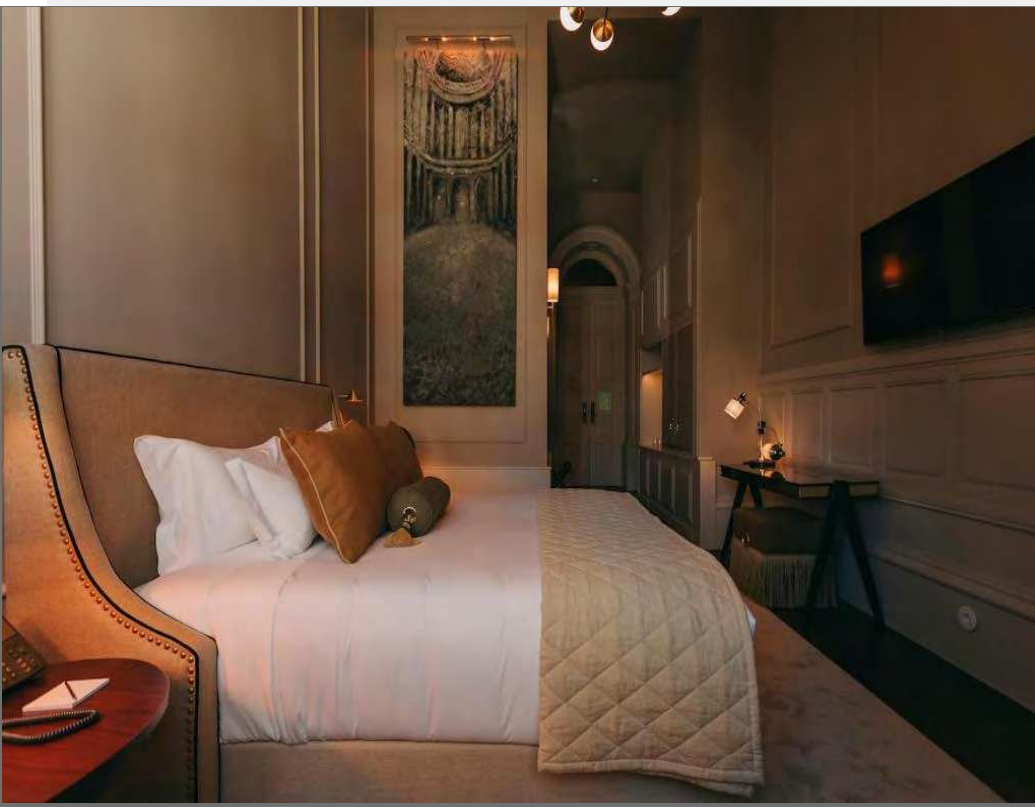

Walking Tour of *Porto*
