

FEATURED ACTIVITY

St. Andrews *Cathedral*

Known as the largest church in Scotland, St Andrews Cathedral fell into disuse during the Scottish Reformation movement during the 16th century when the Catholic mass was outlawed in Scotland. The large complex of impressive ruins is free to visit.







OPTIONAL COURSE

Jubilee Course

The third championship course at the Home of Golf, the Jubilee is considered by many to be the most challenging course on the famous Links. Built in 1897, it was originally intended for use by ladies and beginners; however, after seeing its prime golfing location between the New Course and the sea, the Jubilee was converted to a championship layout in 1988.

The New Course

When it comes to golf, few things in St Andrews are new, so don't let the name fool you. The "New" links were laid out in 1895 and therefore it is plenty old and has had loads of time to mature into a first rate Scottish links golf course. Many locals love it as much as the Old Course, and its certainly just as challenging when the wind is up!

The Old Course

The Old Course at St Andrews is considered by many to be the "home of golf" and has hosted a staggering 30 Open Championships. From the looming R&A behind the 1st tee to Hell Bunker, the Road Hole and the Swilcan Bridge, the Old Course is the oldest and most iconic golf course in the world. Ranked #3 in the world, it's on every golfers bucket list!





The Greywalls Hotel

Greywalls Hotel is situated on the edge of Muirfield's championship golf course, on the 9th and 18th holes. There are ample gardens and tennis courts. The on-site Chez Roux restaurant offers a blend of classic French cuisine and local Scottish produce.

Built in 1901, most rooms have views either over the Firth of Forth, or across the gardens and farmland.







Muirfield

Muirfield is the most exclusive club in Scotland and formally named "The Honourable Company of Edinburgh Golfers." Muirfield hosted The Open Championship 16 times, most recently in 2016 when Phil Mickelson lifted the Claret Jug. Ranked #10 in the world by Golf Magazine, it's a true bucket list Experience.









Dunbar Golf *Club*

In the words of one international golf reviewer, a visit to play golf at Dunbar provides 'just about everything you can ask for'. That is certainly true if a challenging links course, stunning scenery and a friendly clubhouse are the elements you think make up the perfect golfing experience. To play on our Open qualifying championship links is to play within yards of waves as they crash onto the rocky shore.
