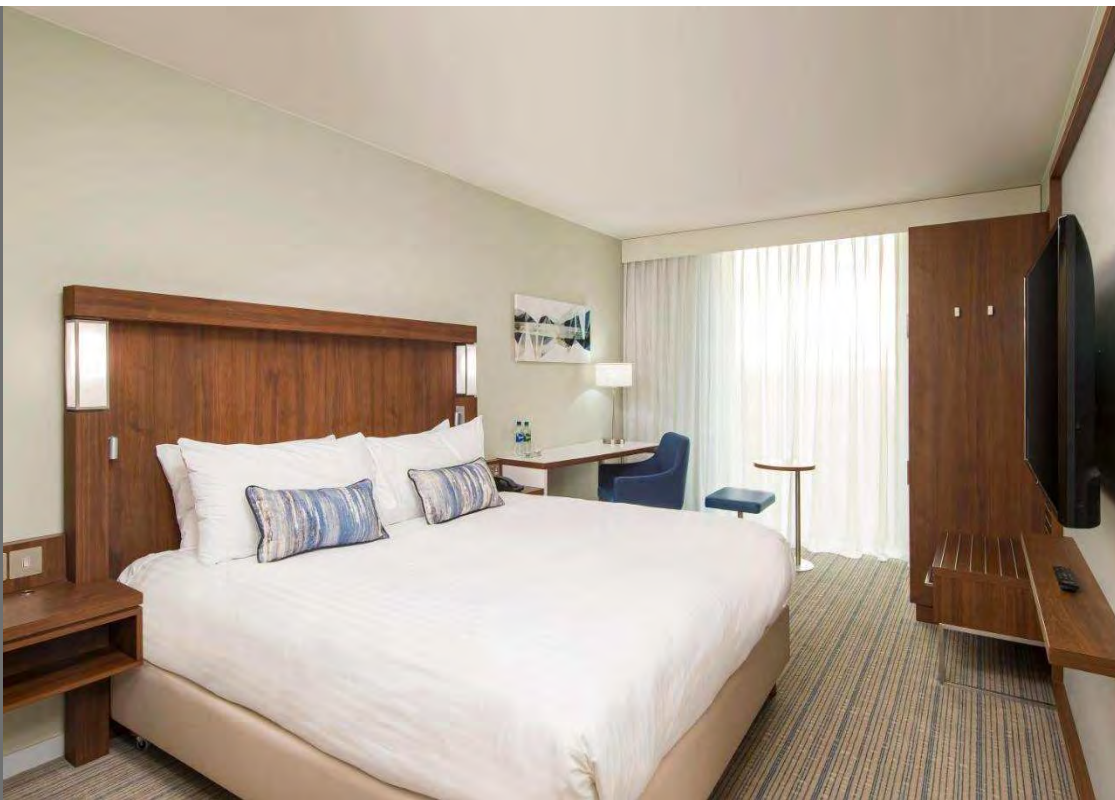

Loch Ness Boat *Tour*

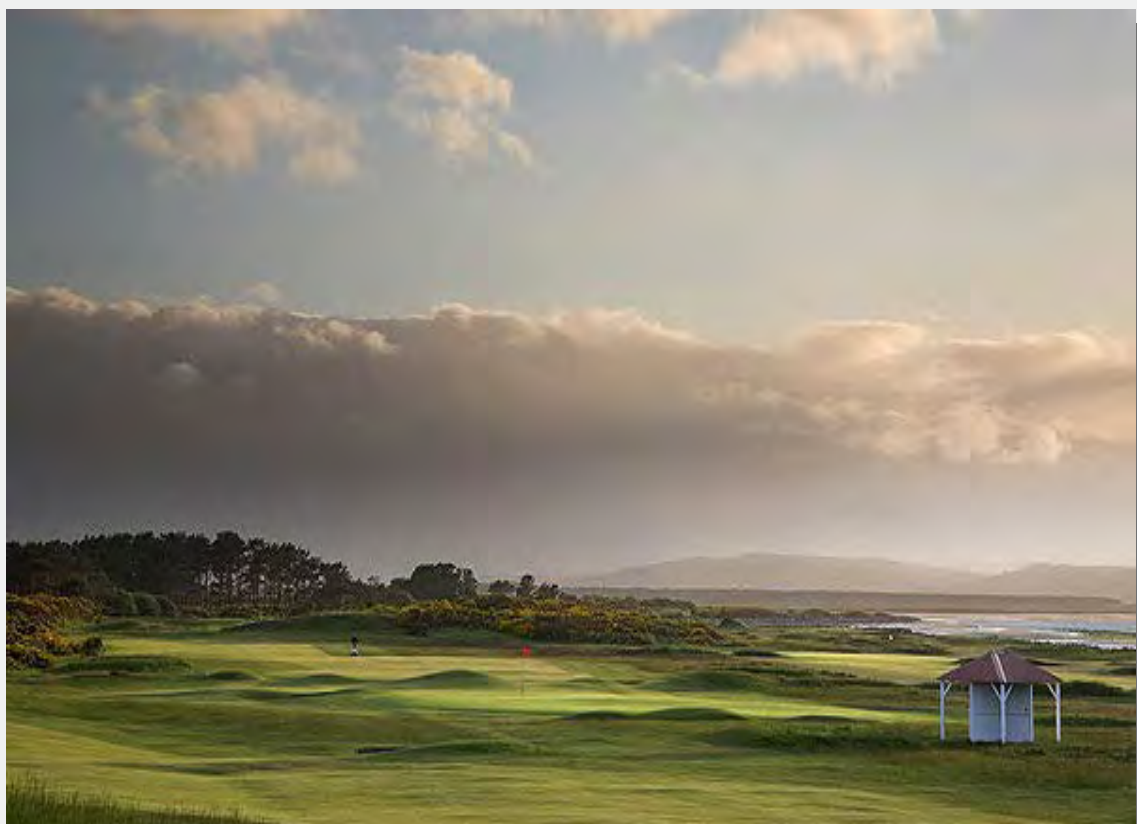

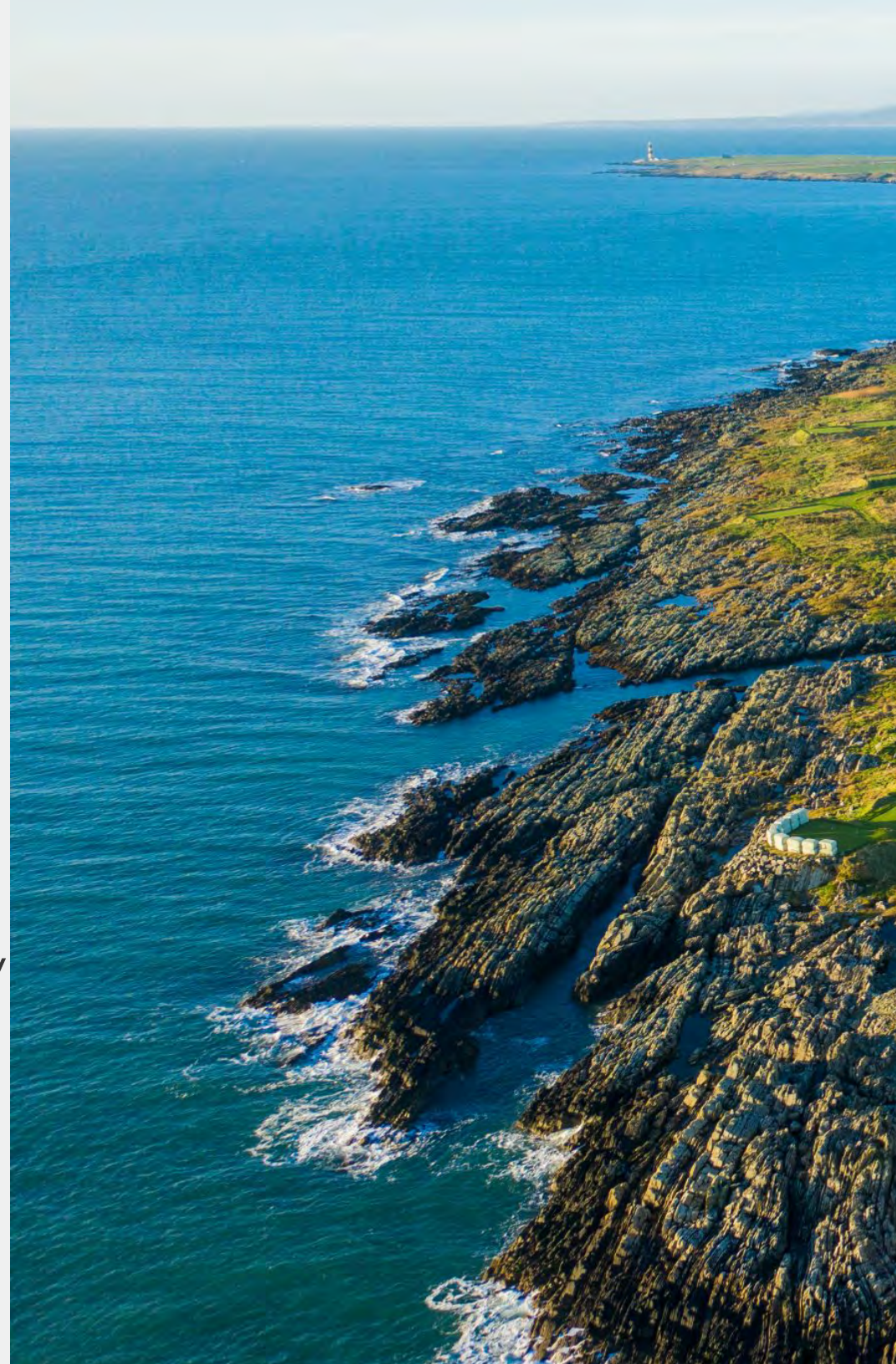
