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

Designed by the renowned Arthur Hills, Oitavos Dunes is a wonderfully challenging yet playable 18 holes that have been laid out to highlight the existing landscape.









Cascais

Found within the historic center are fascinating museums, along with lively bars and restaurants which give Cascais its holiday atmosphere. Its a town that boasts so many interesting sights and attractions, that it is not only regarded as a one of the best day trips from Lisbon, but as a viable alternative to stay, outside of the capital city.







Lisbon

Lisbon is not subtle with its charms. From the first tram ride up that cobbled hill, you will be seduced by glittering river views, some of the most majestic architecture in Europe and, washing lines crammed with colorful underwear. Drink with arty locals at hip new bars, sway to fado, the city's signature sound, and load your suitcase with retro souvenirs. Terras da Comporta Dunas

This amazing new course was recently named #1 new golf course in the world. Located just 1 hour south of Lisbon and designed by David McLay-Kidd, this par 71 golf course meanders perfectly through the 84 hectares of natural, sandy terrain and mature countryside. With sandy dunes framed by umbrella pines, a round of golf here has a nod to a Scottish and Irish links but with a warm sea breeze.





Alentejo Wine Region

A wine producing region with a long tradition, the Alentejo boasts wines that will surprise you for their excellence. The distinct characteristics of the soils according to area (granite, limestone, Mediterranean or schist), the long hours of exposure to the sun and a group of selected grape varieties enable high quality production,

Quinta Do Lago - South

Quinta do Lago has been at the forefront of international golf since it's creation. Today the three courses are among some of Europe's best and are the home to the Paul McGinley golf academy. The South course is the crown jewel of Quinta do Lago- it was recently named Europe's #1 golf course and has hosted the Portugal Open 7 times.









Algarve Coast

Sail along the Algarve Coast, take in the seaside town of Lagos and its natural harbor, admire the golden cliffs that have been carved into beautiful formations over centuries. This history of Portugal will excite you and the natural coast landscape is sure to take your breath away.







Faro

Faro is a historic and culturally rich city that boasts a variety of fascinating attractions. Found within the historic quarter is a gothic cathedral the Paco Episcopal palace. Outside of the city walls is a vibrant city with pedestrianization shopping streets, characterful plazas and a wide variety of restaurants and bars. To the south of Faro is the Parque Natural da Ria Formosa, a series of saltwater lagoons and waterways, which is an important ecosystem for migratory birds and marine life

Ombria

Ombria was designed by Jorge Santana da Silva, who followed a sustainable vision to complement and enhance the natural landscape. Weaving around ancient rivers and trees that have stood for generations, it has achieved the standards of golf's most prestigious ecolabel certifications and created a naturally diverse setting for a truly memorable round of golf.









Cacela Velha

Cacela Velha is a tiny village located on a hill at the eastern end of the Ria Formosa. It's a delightful day trip from anywhere in the Algarve and avoids much of the overcrowding that happens elsewhere on the coast. It's famous for several things, the incredible views it offers, its expansive sandy beach, and its idyllic village protected by a small walled fortress.





Tavira

Tavira is one of th most charming towns in the Algarve. It lies alongside the slow flowing Gilao River and is a delightful mix of traditional Portuguese heritage with deep rooted Moorish influences. Concealed within the labyrinth of cobbled street are traditional tiled houses, family fun restaurants and a myriad of decorative churches

Monte Rei

Monte Rei Golf Course is set in the picturesque foothills of the Eastern Algarve, with sweeping views of the Serra do Caldeirão mountains to the north and the Atlantic Ocean to the south.
