Auckland

Titirangi. In Maori the name means "fringe of heaven". Perhaps Dr. Alister Mackenzie had the meaning in the back of his mind when he designed the Titirangi Golf Course in 1927. For there is indeed something heavenly about playing Titirangi's majestic 18 holes, with its rolling fairways weaving their way through a beautiful backdrop of native New Zealand bush. Titirangi is the only Golf Course in New Zealand where Dr. Alister MacKenzie worked his genius.

Jack's Point

The John Darby designed 18-hole par 72 course provides a range of challenges for both experienced and beginner golfers. The 6,388-meter undulating course follows natural contours and features tussock grasslands, dramatic rocky outcrops and steep bluffs offset by striking alpine and lake views.



Porters *Hotel*

Cape Kidnappers

Cape Kidnappers was designed by Tom Doak and completed in 2004. The course has stunning sea views, playing high above the ocean atop dramatic cliffs. It is built on a ridge-and-valley landscape and has been hailed as one of the great modern marvels in golf.







Hawke's Bay Winery

The Hawke's Bay wine region is the oldest and the second most productive wine region in the country and is best known for its full-bodied red wines and Chardonnay. The region is internationally renowned for producing a wide range of varieties to a very high standard.

Te Arai Suites

The Suites at Te Arai Links are luxurious in design and offer 45m2 (484sf) of beautifully appointed space with contemporary details. The Suites offer lovely views of the South Course and in some instances views of the Pacific Ocean and islands beyond. Located just a short walk from the South Clubhouse, Pizza Barn and practice facilities, the Suites are located in the heart of the property.











Te Arai Links *South*

Te Arai's South Course land forms vary from heaving sand ridges and meandering valleys to rumpled contours reminiscent of the classic seaside links on which the game began. These contours are the foundation and inspiration for the golf holes of Te Arai Links. The holes are as varied in appearance and character as the land itself.



Te Arai Links North

Starting and finishing on the Ocean, the 18 hole, par 71 golf course has been designed as a traditional walking links golf experience. Designed by Tom Doak, you can expect the North Course near the top of its class. Playing very differently than the South Course, with more inland golf and unique green shapes.
