Adare Manor

Adare Manor was a labor of love from the very start, created to delight, astonish and impress. That legacy is vividly alive in the manor house itself: sumptuously restored, brimming with gothic splendor, and perfectly appointed in every detail.







Adare Village

With its picture postcard main street of thatched cottages and medieval buildings, Adare village is rich in ancient and archaeological remains with a history dating back to 1200 AD and a unique attractiveness which has made it a popular tourist destination. Just 5 minutes outside the village sits Adare Manor, home of the Ryder Cup in 2026 and a stunning 5 star hotel that historically was the once the family seat of the Earls of Dunraven







FEATURED COURSE

Lahinch

A round at Lahinch is an exciting adventure and an exacting test. It's a supremely natural course and one where every shot in the bag will be tested. The fairways run through huge grass-covered dunes to fast greens with devilish run-offs.





Doonbeg Links

Spanning 1.5 miles of crescent shaped beach and sand dunes, the Dr Martin Hawtree newly redesigned course at Trump International Golf Links Doonbeg is a stunning sight to behold and offers views of the Atlantic from 16 of 18 holes. The average time taken for a round of golf is four hours and thirty minutes. The par-72 layout features a single loop of nine holes out and nine back, playing 7,026 yards from the back tees.







Cliffs of Moher

One of Ireland's favorite visitor experiences, the Cliffs of Moher tower over the rugged West Clare coast. Walk the safe, paved pathways and view the famous Cliffs on Europe's western frontier and enjoy the spectacular vistas over the Atlantic Ocean and the Aran Islands.







Hayfield Manor

Among the rolling green hills and fields of southern Ireland lies the picturesque city of Cork, and within that sits multi-award-winning Hayfield Manor, a grand old manor house turned luxurious Irish escape where traditional comforts meet modern hospitality and personalized service. Step into the world of this ivy-covered brick mansion, where rooms are dressed in polished wood paneling, sumptuous and ornate carpets and drapes, elegant furniture, and fine linens, with views of a two-acres private walled garden







Old Head

Old Head Golf Links is built on a 220-acre diamond of land jutting out over two miles into the Atlantic Ocean. The promontory is almost an island with numerous caves running beneath your feet as you play the course. It is a piece of golf real estate like no other, that causes many a golfer and visitor to pinch themselves as they drive through the ancient gateway with the crashing waves of the Atlantic Ocean some 300 feet below.









Kinsale

Located at the start of the Wild Atlantic Way, Kinsale town is famous for its colorful streetscapes and rich history, fueled by great people, food, boutiques & events. Kinsale is a vibrant coastal town with an energetic personality that will keep you entertained while you visit.





Cork Golf Club

Over the years this Alister Mackenzie designed course has matured to become one of the finest inland courses in Ireland. Founded in 1888, it is no wonder then that Cork Golf Club (or Little Island as it is sometimes known) has hosted many Amateur and Professional Championships including the Irish Close Championships and Irish Open. On the shores of Lough Mahon, Mackenzie's genius is evident throughout, with accuracy off the tee vital and imagination and precision with the irons equally crucial.









Cork


Sitting proudly on an island in the middle of the River Lee, Cork's feel good buzz surges through its hip coffee shops, vibrant art galleries, off-beat museums and seriously good pubs. Despite being a city, there's a decidedly towny feel here – life is laid back, nothing is too much hassle.











Blarney Castle & Stone

This historic castle is most famous for its stone, which has the traditional power of conferring eloquence on all who kiss it. The word Blarney was introduced into the English language by Queen Elizabeth I and is described as pleasant talk, intended to deceive without offending. The stone is set in the wall below the battlements, and to kiss it one has to lean backwards (grasping an iron railing) from the parapet walk



Great Southern Hotel, *Killarney*

Great Southern Killarney still stands proudly as Killarney's Premier Historic Hotel and is situated on 6 acres of beautiful gardens right in the heart of Killarney town center. Guest facilities include the gourmet Garden Room Restaurant, the welcoming meeting point Brownes - The Bar and The Killarney Wine Room, home to the hotel's wine tasting experience









Killarney

Killarney is one of the warmest and most welcoming towns in Ireland. Feel instantly at home as you wander down the streets, grab a tasty meal and relax in a comfortable pub. The town is part of Killarney National Park, the Ring of Kerry and is a fantastic place to base yourself as you explore the sublime beauty of the area. Sights like Torc Waterfall, Gap of Dunloe and Muckross House will make memories that last a lifetime.







Waterville

Waterville plays on a promontory surrounded by the sea. It's a stunning, remote location with views to the northeast of the Macgillycuddy's Reeks mountain range and to the southwest across the beautiful Ballinskelligs Bay and the Atlantic Ocean. The fairways are gently undulating, the front nine plays across relatively flat ground whilst the back nine weaves its way through avenues of tall dunes.







Ring of Kerry

The Ring of Kerry is a scenic drive around the Iveragh Peninsula in southwest Ireland's County Kerry. Its 179km-long, circular route takes in rugged and verdant coastal landscapes and rural seaside villages.. The route takes around 3.5 hours to drive around without stopping. However, it's always better to take your time to experience the vast variety of nature, culture and activities as well as some of the pubs and restaurants that pepper this superb peninsula.





Tralee

Situated on the rugged Atlantic coast of Ireland's south west, the links features towering dunes, undulating fairways, punishing rough and cliff top tees and greens. Designed and built by Arnold Palmer, this stunning setting represents a true paradise for those willing to challenge what is widely acclaimed as one of the finest links courses in the world.









Dingle Peninsula

The Dingle Peninsula is truly beautiful and sits on Ireland's southwest Atlantic coast, it is ringed by sandy beaches and craggy cliffs. Inland are rolling hills and mountains, including the 952m Mount Brandon. The region is an officially recognized bastion of Irish language and culture. Dunmore Head, mainland Ireland's easternmost point, has views of the Blasket Islands, famous for Irish-language memoirs documenting rural life in the 1800s and 1900s







Ballybunion

Located on the north-west coast of County Kerry, on a beautiful stretch of sand dunes overlooking the Atlantic Ocean, you'll find two wonderfully challenging and unique world-class links golf courses at Ballybunion – the Old Course and the Trent Jones Cashen Course. Whatever your choice, every hole, every hazard and every shot is defined by nature's infinite presence.
