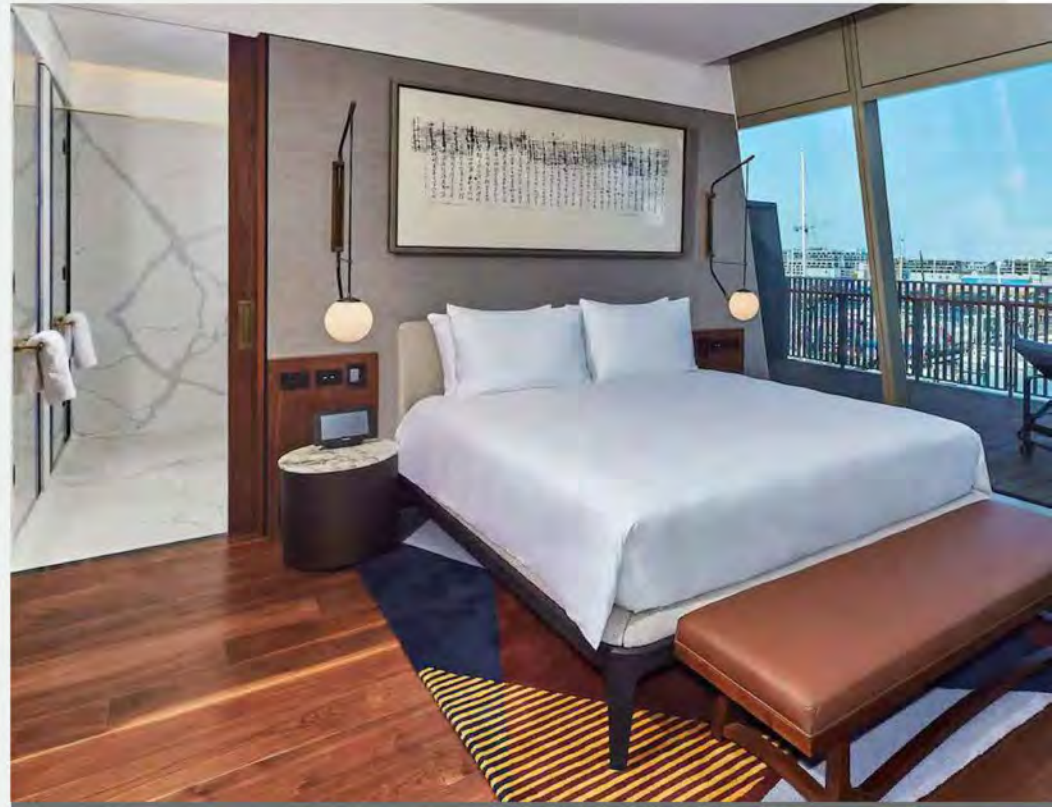

# Jack's *Point*

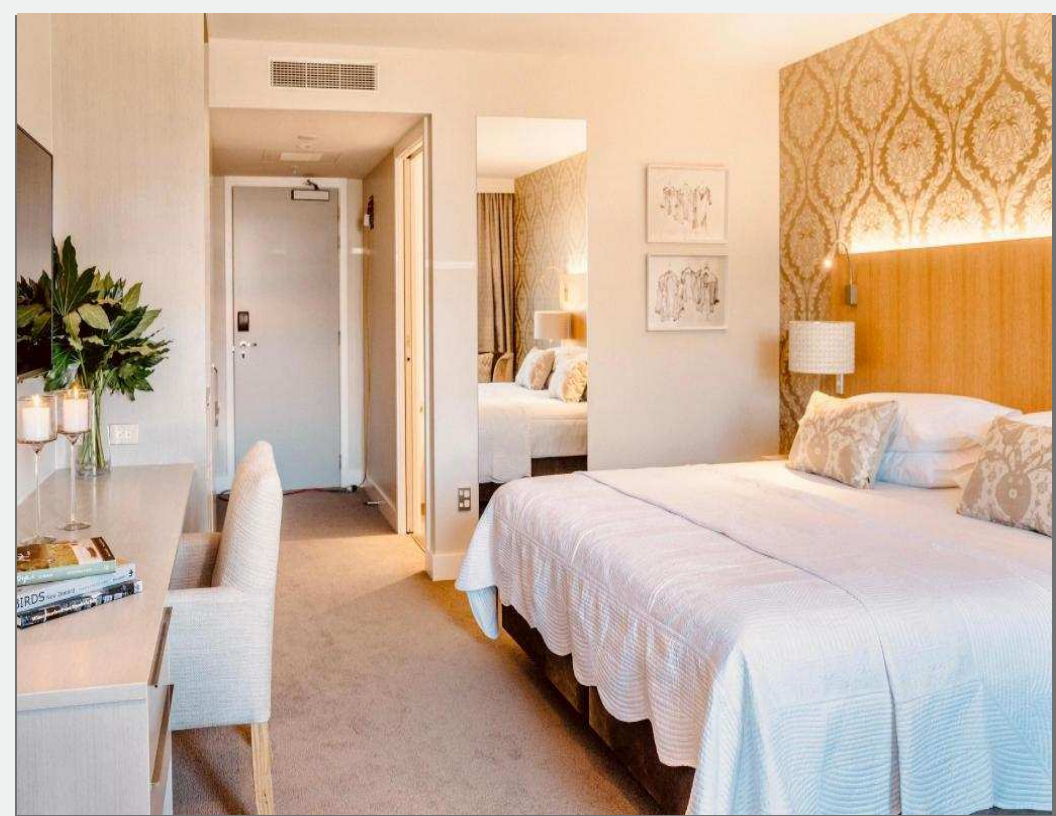

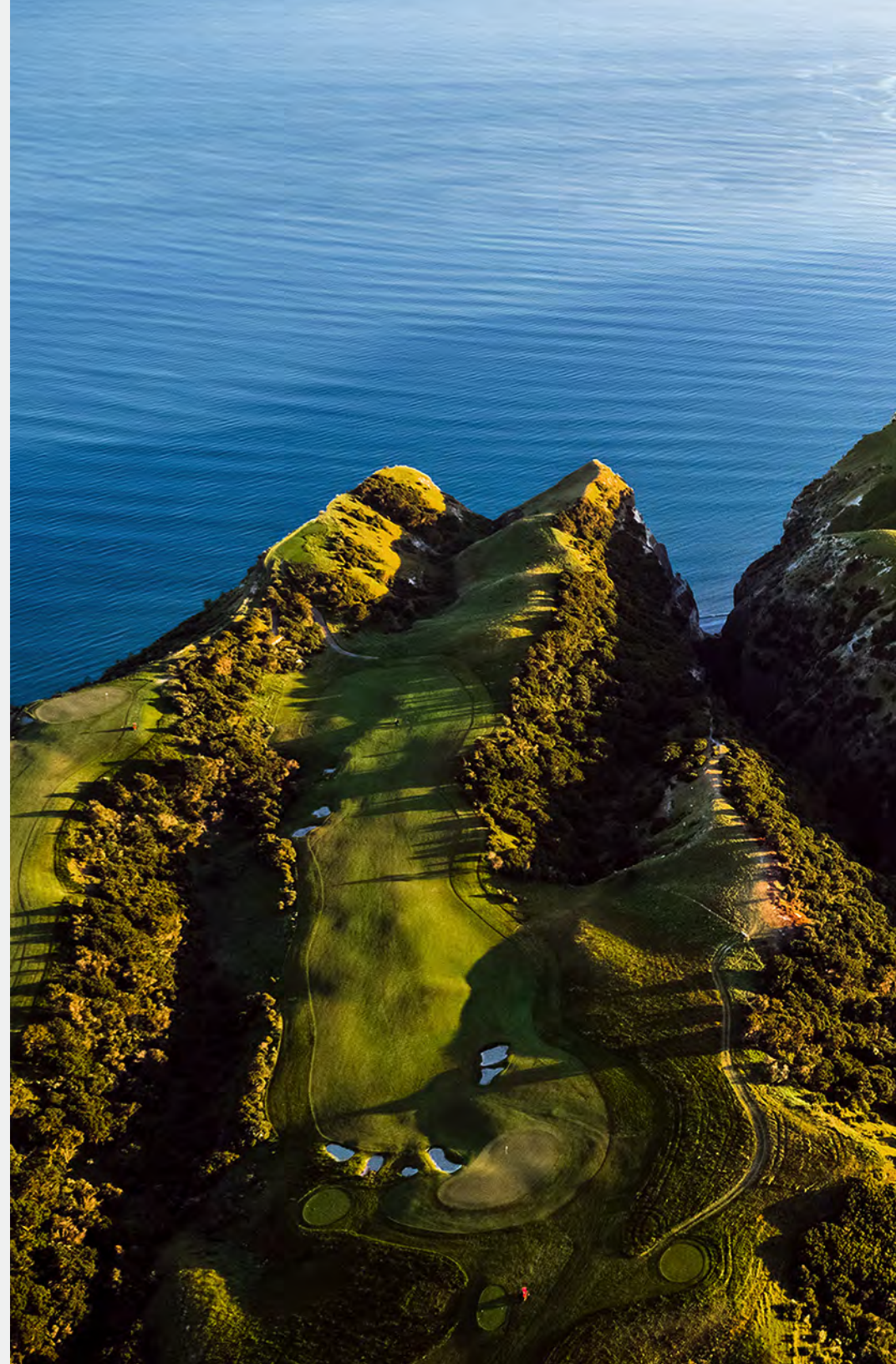
