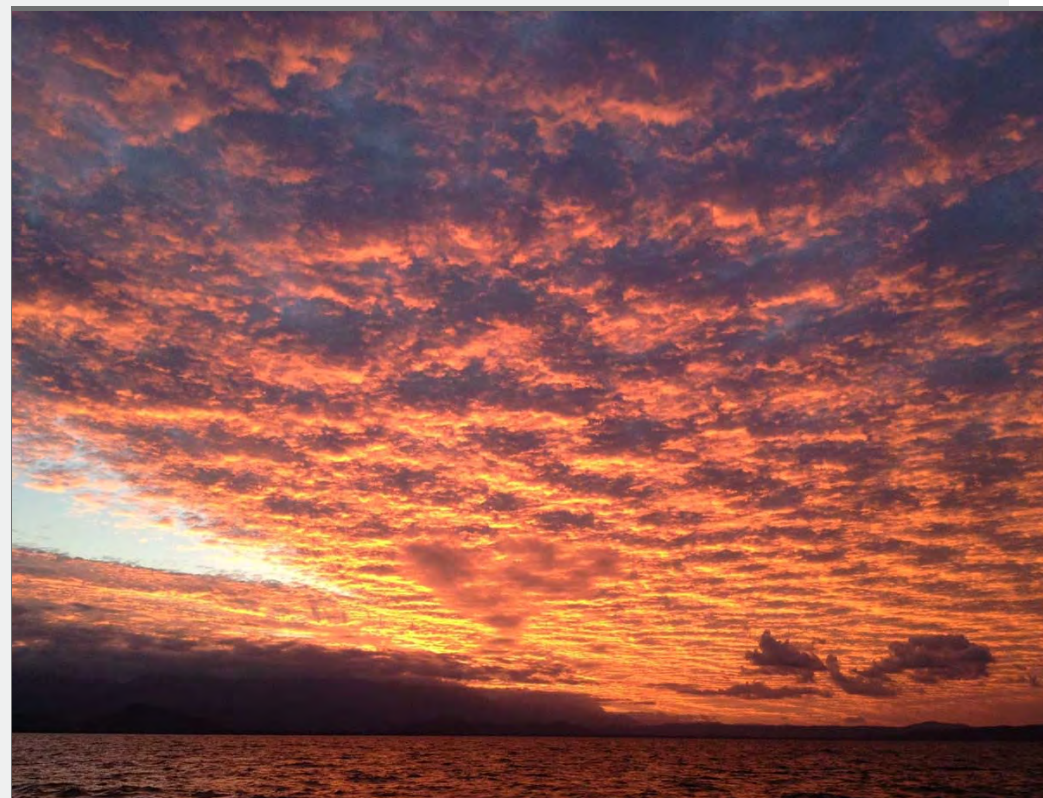




OPTIONAL ACTIVITY

Historic *Arrowtown*

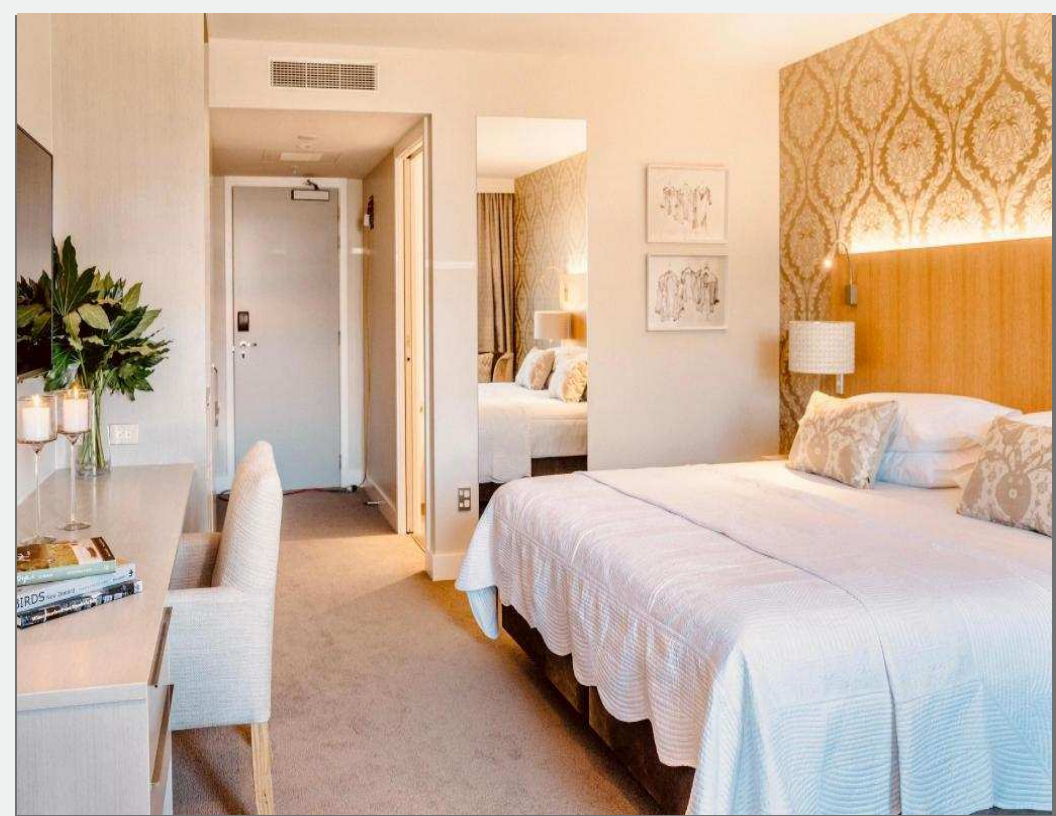
