

# InterContinental *Lisbon*

Located next to the peaceful Parque Eduardo VII, just above the Avenida da Liberdade and with views over the old city and the Tagus River, the InterContinental Lisbon offers a unique setting for your stay in Lisbon.









## Lisbon

Lisbon is not subtle with its charms. From the first tram ride up that cobbled hill, you will be seduced by glittering river views, some of the most majestic architecture in Europe and, washing lines crammed with colorful underwear. Drink with arty locals at hip new bars, sway to fado, the city's signature sound, and load your suitcase with retro souvenirs. For a capital city, they don't get much prettier, and it's outstandingly good value, too.







# Cultural Lisbon

Lisbon, the starting point for 16th century Portuguese explorers. Here, see the Belém Tower that once stood in the middle of the Tagus River, stand in awe of the architecture of Mosteiro dos Jerónimos, a monastery of the Manuelien style and visit Castle St George for a breathtaking view of the city.







# Sintra

With its rippling mountains, dewy forests thick with ferns and lichen, exotic gardens and glittering palaces, Sintra is like a page torn from a fairy tale. Its UNESCO World Heritage–listed center, Sintra-Vila, is dotted with pastel-hued manors folded into luxuriant hills that roll down to the blue Atlantic.







### Cascais

Cascais is the premier holiday destination of the Lisbon coastline. It is a traditional and charming fishing town that has responsibly developed into a popular resort town. Found within the historic center are fascinating museums, along with lively bars and restaurants which give Cascais its holiday atmosphere. Its a town that boasts so many interesting sights and attractions, that it is not only regarded as a one of the best day trips from Lisbon, but as a viable alternative to stay, outside of the capital city.



### Oitavos Dunes GC

Golf Magazine's #1 in Portugal and #55 in the World, Oitavos Dunes peers down at the Atlantic Ocean at every turn. A 5 star private club, Oitavos Dunes is a lovely mix of woodland and links style holes. Designed by the renowned Arthur Hills, Oitavos Dunes is a wonderfully challenging yet playable 18 holes that have been laid out to highlight the existing landscape.









# Terras da Comporta Dunas

In the blink of an eye this course has become a must play for anyone visiting Portugal to play golf. it is located just an hour south of Lisbon.

Designed by David McLay-Kidd, this par 71 golf course meanders perfectly through th 84 hectares of natural, sandy terrain and mature countryside. With sandy dunes framed by umbrella pines, a round of golf here has a nod to a Scottish and Irish links bit with a warm sea breeze





# The Dona Filipa *Hotel*

The five-star Dona Filipa Hotel is surrounded by lush greenery and panoramic ocean views that stretch for miles. Newly refurbished to the highest standards of luxury, the hotel blends modern design with classic Portuguese style... and is in a perfect location for your Portugal Experience in the Algarve.









# Algarve Coast


Sail along the Algarve Coast, take in the seaside town of Lagos and its natural harbor, admire the golden cliffs that have been carved into beautiful formations over centuries. This history of Portugal will excite you and the natural coast landscape is sure to take your breath away.





## Monte Rei

Monte Rei Golf Course, is set in the picturesque foothills of the Eastern Algarve, with sweeping views of the Serra do Caldeirão mountains to the north and the Atlantic Ocean to the south. A truly unique design; with water coming into play on eleven of the eighteen holes, Monte Rei golf course features an enjoyable series of eight par-4s, five par-3s and five par-5s in a challenging and distinctive layout.









## Cacela Velha

Cacela Velha is a tiny village located on a hill at the eastern end of the Ria Formosa. It's a delightful day trip from anywhere in the Algarve and avoids much of the overcrowding that happens elsewhere on the coast. It's famous for several things, the incredible views it offers, its expansive sandy beach, and its idyllic village protected by a small walled fortress.





# Tavira

Tavira is one of th most charming towns in the Algarve. It lies alongside the slow flowing Gilao River and is a delightful mix of traditional Portuguese heritage with deep rooted Moorish influences. Concealed within the labyrinth of cobbled street are traditional tiled houses, family fun restaurants and a myriad of decorative churches









## Dom Pedro Old

In the heart of Vilamoura lies the "Grande Dame" of Algarve golf courses, Dom Pedro Old Course. As one of the first-established layouts in the region, the Frank Pennink-design is well regarded throughout the golfing world. Although it is but a mere 20-minute drive from Faro Airport, the course finds itself situated amongst impressive pine trees and set out over gently undulating terrain.







# Quinta Do Lago - South

Quinta do Lago has been at the forefront of international golf since it's creation. Today the three courses are among some of Europe's best and are the home to the Paul McGinley golf academy. The South course is the crown jewel of Quinta do Lago and is a continued favorite of European Tour players, having hosted the Portugal Open 7 times.









#### Faro

Faro is a historic and culturally rich city that boasts a variety of fascinating attractions. Found within the historic quarter is a gothic cathedral the Paco Episcopal palace. Outside of the city walls is a vibrant city with pedestrianization shopping streets, characterful plazas and a wide variety of restaurants and bars. To the south of Faro is the Parque Natural da Ria Formosa, a series of saltwater lagoons and waterways, which is an important ecosystem for migratory birds and marine life
