# Sunningdale - *Old*

Sunningdale's Old Course was designed by Willie Park Jr and opened in 1901. Its heathland layout (not parkland, not links) takes on a journey through hills, heather and woodland that is simply majestic. This is the premier golf club in England, and ranked in the world top 40. The clubhouse is among the most iconic in golf, and the golf (including the New Course) ranks as among the best 36 hole facilities in the world. Magnificent!

# Windsor & The Castle

Rich in history and royal tradition, explore a town that has been home to British royalty for centuries. You'll discover a lively town in a glorious riverside location with great shopping, restaurants and Windsor Castle - one of the late Queen Elizabeth's official royal residences and the largest and oldest occupied castle in the world. Founded by William the Conqueror in the 11th century.

# *Hampton Court Palace*

Explore the home of Henry VIII, his wives and children, in the unique world of the Tudor court. The splendid formal gardens, elegant cobbled courtyards and magnificent Tudor and Baroque architecture of Hampton Court Palace make this 500-year old treasure a spectacular must visit attraction. # Swinley Forest

Established in 1909, Swinley Forest GC is located near Sunningdale and the other great Berkshire courses. Another of the great Harry Colt's classic designs, Swinley Forest is straightforward, classic heathland golf on a course and at only par 69, considered one of the hardest and most memorable courses in all of England. 6400 yards at most, this is pure old school English golf, complete with members walking with their dogs.
