### Portstewart Strand

Founded in 1894 and redesigned by Willie Park, Jr. in the 1920's, this championship links course received its greatest makeover with the purchase of land known as "Thistly Hollow" in 1981. The Strand Course is the jewel in the Portstewart portfolio.







# Giant's Causeway

The Giant's Causeway is a renowned natural wonder located on the northeast coast of Northern Ireland, near the town of Bushmills in County Antrim. It is one of the most popular tourist attractions in Northern Ireland and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The Giant's Causeway consists of approximately 40,000 interlocking basalt columns, the result of an ancient volcanic eruption around 60 million years ago.







### Royal Portrush

The Dunluce Links is rated as one of the most challenging and spectacular links courses in the world. The original architect was the famed Harry Colt who produced a breathtaking golf links opening up views of the Atlantic Ocean. In 2015, for the hosting of The Open in 2019, redesign works commenced under the stewardship of Martin Ebert. The result is a magnificent layout providing a fair and scenically stunning challenge for golfers to enjoy.

# Marine *Troon*

The Marine Troon is a luxury Scottish hotel, overlooking the 18th hole of the Royal Troon golf course on the stunning Ayrshire coast. The Marine Troon Hotel offers breathtaking views of the Isle of Arran and is the perfect base to explore Ayrshire, and the West coast of Scotland









# Turnberry Ailsa

Trump Turnberry is a world renowned bucket list golf destination and the Ailsa Course which has hosted The Open Championship four times, currently resides at No.18 in the Golf.com World Top 100 rankings. Set alongside the glorious Ayrshire coastline, with Arran and Ailsa Craig as a stunning backdrop, it truly is one of the finest golfing destinations in the world.





### Western Gailes

The reputation of Western Gailes as one of the game's finest and more exacting courses has spread worldwide as evidenced by its numerous visitors from around the world including golfing legends from this and the last century. The great Harry Vardon arrived at Western Gailes in June 1903 celebrating his fourth Open victory. In 1923, its attractions were being lauded by the then US Open Champion Gene Sarazen who played the course with three other outstanding professionals.









# Prestwick Golf *Club*

Prestwick Golf Club is a golf course in Prestwick, South Ayrshire, Scotland. It is approximately 30 miles southwest of Scotland's largest city, Glasgow. Prestwick is a classic links course, built on the rolling sandy land between the beach and the hinterland.





# Dundonald Links

Located at the very heart of Ayrshire's golf coast lies a modern links golf masterpiece. Designed by Kyle Phillips, Dundonald Links was home to the Aberdeen Asset Management Ladies Scottish Open in 2015, 2016 and 2017, and The Aberdeen Asset Management Scottish Open in 2017. Set in the heart of Scotland, in 2021, Dundonald Links will be the place to come – from its stunning golf course to its five-star facilities.







# Royal *Troon*

Royal Troon is a traditional out and back links course. The opening few holes are relatively gentle, with a series of short par fours running along the Firth of Clyde. It's from these early holes that you get the chance to soak up the views. On a clear day, you can see the distant Ailsa Craig in the south, and to the west, the majestic mountains on the Isle of Arran.
