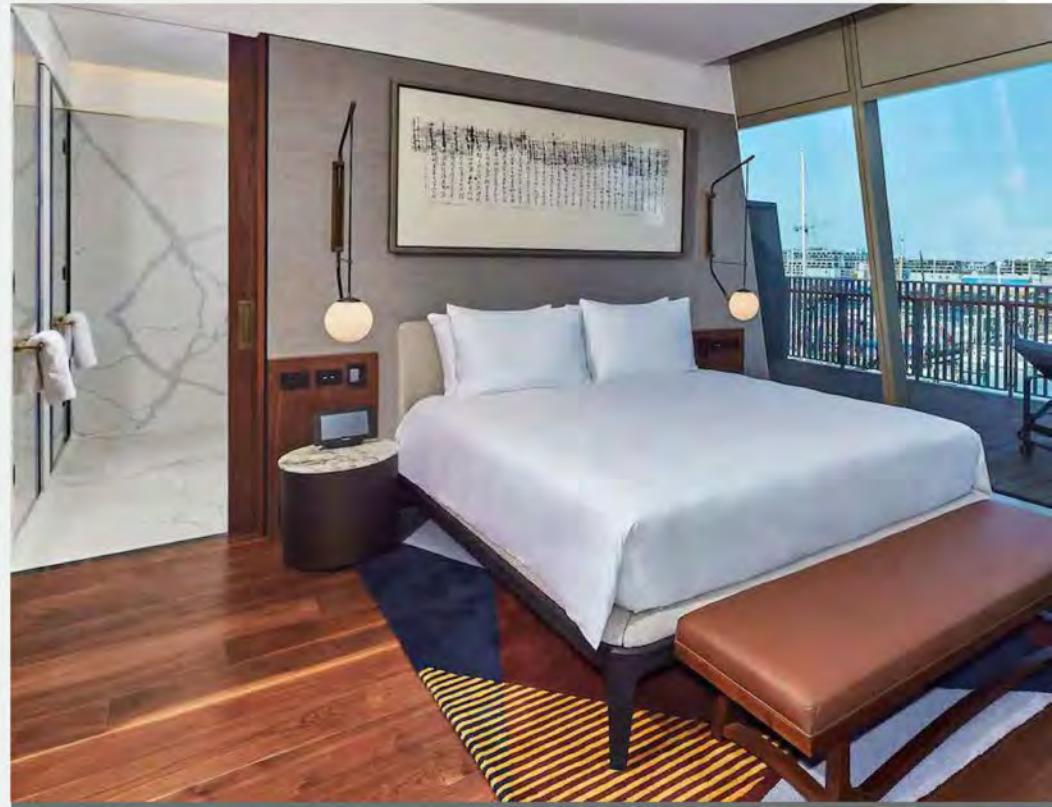

Te Arai Links *North*

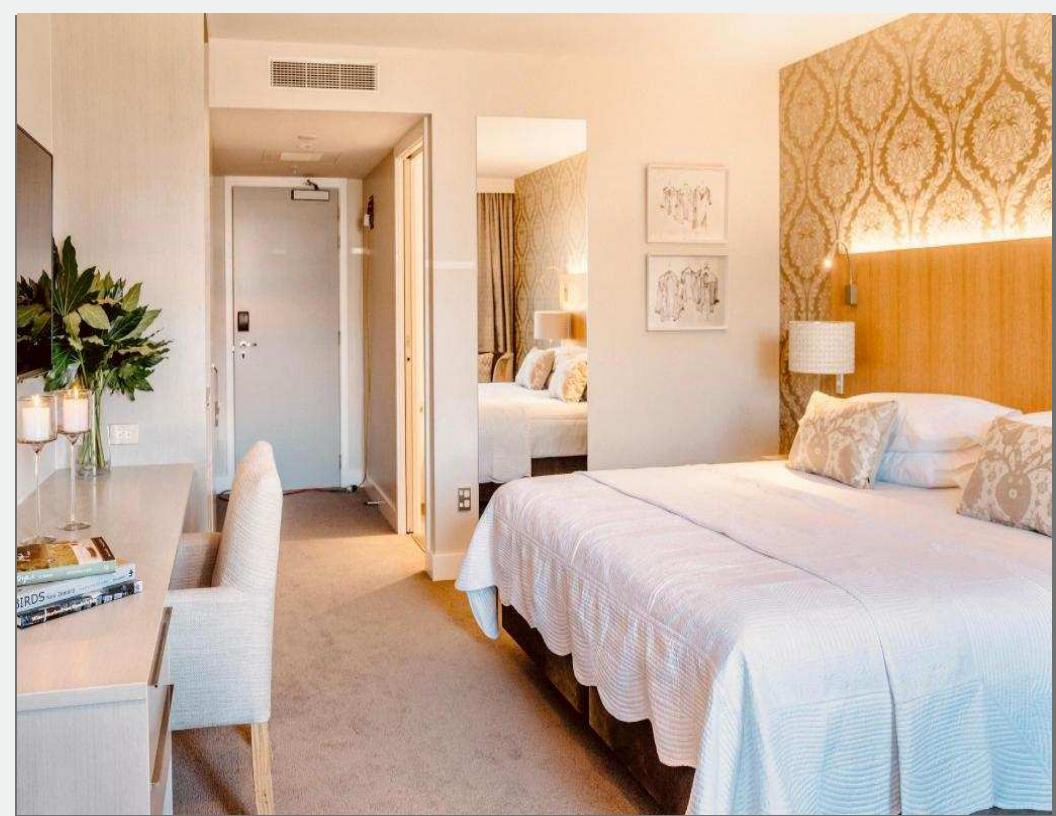

Queenstown

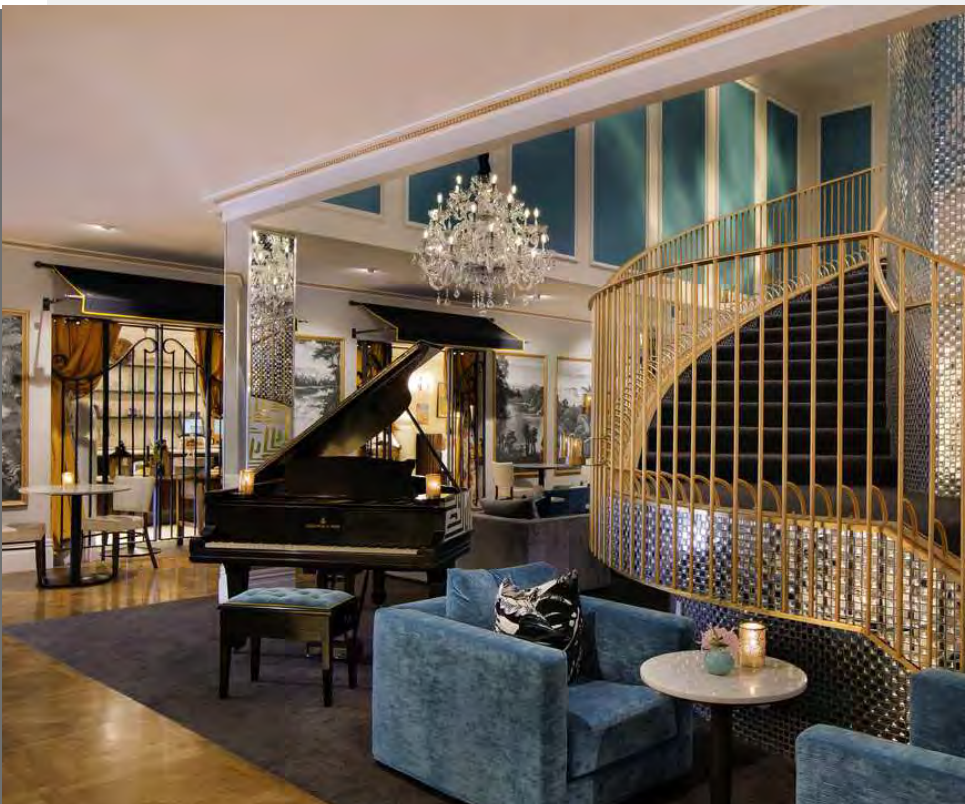

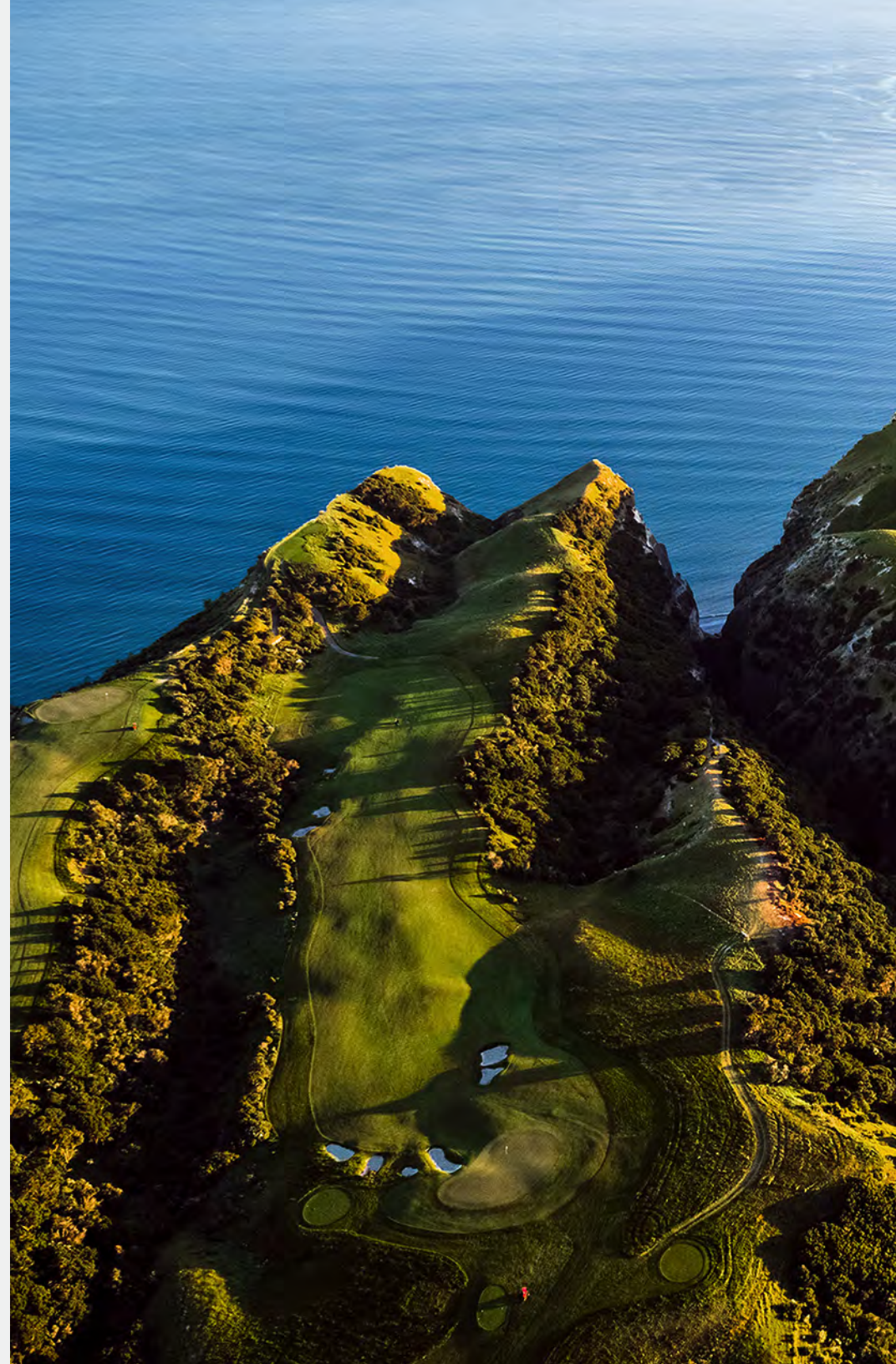
