# Jack's Point

The John Darby designed 18-hole par 72 course provides a range of challenges for both experienced and beginner golfers. The 6,388-meter undulating course follows natural contours and features tussock grasslands, dramatic rocky outcrops and steep bluffs offset by striking alpine and lake views.





# The Hills Golf Club

Experience one of the most unique and exclusive rounds in New Zealand. The Hills Golf Club is primarily a Private Members Club, offering limited availability for visitors to play among works of art while experiencing dramatic elevation changes and rocky schist outcrops across a glacial valley.









# Rosewood Cape *Kidnappers*

Located in the Hawke's Bay and set on 6,000 acres of dramatic coastline, The Rosewood Cape Kidnappers offers spectacular views from every angle of the Pacific Ocean. On the exterior, the lodge resembles a cluster of farm buildings, whilst on the interior guests will find graciously scaled rooms full of natural light and unexpected treasures.

# Cape Kidnappers

Cape Kidnappers was designed by Tom Doak and completed in 2004. The course has stunning sea views, playing high above the ocean atop dramatic cliffs. It is built on a ridge-and-valley landscape and has been hailed as one of the great modern marvels in golf.





## Te Arai Suites

The Suites at Te Arai Links are luxurious in design and offer 45m2 (484sf) of beautifully appointed space with contemporary details. The Suites offer lovely views of the South Course and in some instances views of the Pacific Ocean and islands beyond. Located just a short walk from the South Clubhouse and practice facilities, the Suites are located in the heart of the property.









# Te Arai Links South

Te Arai's South Course land forms vary from heaving sand ridges and meandering valleys to rumpled contours reminiscent of the classic seaside links on which the game began. These contours are the foundation and inspiration for the golf holes of Te Arai Links. The holes are as varied in appearance and character as the land itself.





# Te Arai Links North

Starting and finishing on the Ocean, the 18 hole, par 71 golf course has been designed as a traditional walking links golf experience. Designed by Tom Doak, you can expect the North Course near the top of its class. Playing very differently than the South Course, with more inland golf and unique green shapes.
